Since 2007, she has been a member of the Technical Panel for English of the Commission on Higher Education (CHED). Her research interests in World Englishes, Contrastive Rhetoric, and Sociolinguistics motivated her to deliver papers here and abroad and publish articles in scholarly journals such as *Asian Englishes*, *The Asia-Pacific Education Researcher*, *the Philippine Journal of Linguistics*, and *UNITAS*. She is also a contributing editor of *ELTWO: Voices from the Classroom* of the Centre for English Language Communication of the National University of Singapore and a textbook writer for UST, Trailblazer Publications, Rex Bookstore, Diwa Scholastic Press, Inc. and coordinator for HS English Textbooks of ANVIL Publishing.
